Case Study on SSBCI - Wastewater Treatment System





OVERVIEW

The Authority's State Small Business Credit Initiative (SSBCI) program has participated in funding for a new wastewater treatment system (Gas Energy Mixing System) to eliminate fat, oils and grease from entering the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRD) regulated water.

KEY FACTS

OPTIMAL FUNDING

The Authority was able to provide **100%** financing, requiring no equity from the business. The financing covered all equipment, construction, design, management and startup costs.

GREEN SAVINGS

In addition to 100% financing, the Authority facilitated a reduction in the lead lender rate of **6.62%** to **3.81%** fixed, by utilizing a below market rate of **1%** on the participation funding. This effectively saved the business **\$233,000** over the loan term.

SOLUTIONS IMPLEMENTED

With the support of the Authority, a Gas Energy Mixing System by Clean Water Technology was installed, producing clean water for years to come. This positively affects not only the business but surrounding communities as well, cultivating a safer and more sustainable environment for everyone.

CONCLUSION

With a combination of rate reduction, program variety, and ample funding the Authority aims to assist eligible businesses with accelerated dissemination of private capital. Efforts to advance these forward-looking objectives do not end with wastewater treatment. Opportunities are extended to a multitude of industries and projects including solar installation, fleet electrification and community charging.
